### A. Explanatory notes pursuant to MFRS 134

#### A1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of MFRS 134: *Interim Financial Reporting* and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of Guan Chong Berhad ("GCB" or the "Company") and its subsidiaries ("Group") for the financial year ended 31 December 2016. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2016.

### A2. Significant accounting policies

The audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2016 were prepared in accordance with MFRS. The significant accounting policies adopted in preparing this Condensed Report are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016, except for those standards, amendments and IC interpretations which are effective from the annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2017. The adoptions of these standards, amendments and IC interpretations have no material impact on this Condensed Report.

#### A3. Seasonal or cyclical factors

The cocoa processing industry is, to a certain extent, subject to the seasonal pattern of the consumption of cocoa-based products within a year.

#### A4. Unusual nature and amounts affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows

Other than those stated in the notes, there are no other items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence.

#### A5. Material changes in estimates

There was no material changes in estimates of amounts reported that will have a material effect during the current quarter under review.

#### A6. Issuances and repayment of debt and equity securities

There were no issuance, cancellation, repurchase, resale and repayment of debt and equity securities during the current quarter under review.

### A7. Dividends paid

Second interim single-tier dividend of 1.0 sen per ordinary share amounting to RM 4,779,177.52 in respect of the financial year ended 31 December 2017 was declared on 13 November 2017 and subsequently paid on 27 December 2017. The payment was made to shareholders whose names appeared in the Company's Record of Depositors on 28 November 2017.

### A19. Material events subsequent to the end of the current quarter

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### B. Explanatory notes pursuant to Bursa Malaysia Listing Requirements: Chapter 9, Appendix 9B, Part A

#### **B1.** Review of performance

The Group's revenue of RM 493.8 million for the current quarter ended 31 December 2017 is lower than the revenue in the previous corresponding quarter ended 31 December 2016 of RM 543.6 million. The decrease of 9.2% in turnover is mainly due to decrease in sales volume of cocoa solids and overall selling price of cocoa products.

The Group made a profit before tax for the quarter 31 December 2017 of RM 41.8 million as compared with the profit before tax of RM 5.3 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 31 December 2016. This is mainly due to improved margin and also unrealised gain derived from commodity future contract for current quarter ended 31 December 2017 as compared to preceding year corresponding quarter ended 31 December 2016.

### B2. Comment on material change in profit before tax

The Group recorded a profit before tax of RM 41.8 million for the current quarter as compared to a profit before tax of RM 36.4 million in the immediate preceding quarter. This is mainly due to reducing bean purchase price contributing to better profit margin.

### **B3.** Commentary of prospects

The Group expects the business environment for the financial year ending 31 December 2018 to be less volatile. Overall cocoa bean market remains highly competitive while strong growth of global demand for chocolate is projected.

The Group will continue to focus on efforts to explore new markets for its wide range of cocoa ingredients, optimise production according to market conditions and expand overall grinding capacity.

### B4. Profit forecast or profit guarantee

There were no profits forecast or profit guarantee issued by the Group.

There were no corporate proposals announced but not completed as at the date of this report.
